CONTEST ENTRY FORM

Entries must be **postmarked no later** than Feb. 25, 2019

NATURE OF THE CONTESTS

Schools may enter once for each of the three categories (\$13 each category– schools may choose to enter one, two, or all three categories). **How to Submit:** WJEA member schools may provide a **URL to each video/webcast**. All video entries must have been produced by students and originally broadcast or disseminated through a campus student medium. Submit only the entry for each contest. All entries should have been broadcast at school or in the community from April 2018 through February 2019.

IMPORTANT: A student may only enter in one category. Students entering the Broadcast Contest must be present at the Spring Write-offs on March 16, where they will attend a morning feed-back session with least one industry professional.

CATEGORIES

NEWS BROADCAST Submit this registration form and one prerecorded news story containing (usually) a reporter's voice-over, videotaped shots and soundbites. Total Running Time (TRT) 1:30 to 2:00 minutes.

FEATURE BROADCAST Submit this registration form and one prerecorded feature package containing a reporter's voice-over, videotaped shots and sound bites. Subject matter may focus on campus or non-campus topics of interest to a campus audience and may include sports presentations. Total Running Time (TRT) 1:30 to 2:00 minutes.

SPORTS BROADCAST Submit this registration form and one prerecorded sports news story on a timely topic that addresses serious topics related to athletics. For example, these may include investigative reports about facilities, drug use, injuries, budgets, scholarships, rules and regulations, etc. Total Run Time (TRT) 1:30 to 2:00 minutes. Specific judging criteria is available on www.wjea.org.
